



WISCONSIN HOLSTEIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS 2011

This past year WHA Scholarships totaled over \$10,000! Scholarships were awarded to students in either 4-year or one and two year or short course or tech school ag-related programs.

This year again there will be WHA Scholarships given out in the following areas: To a student(s) enrolled in either a four-year, one or two year or short course or tech school ag-related program. These WI Holstein Scholarships range from \$250 to \$1000 to an eligible recipient.

Also being awarded is the Elroy Borgwardt Memorial Scholarship. This is a \$500 scholarship to a student enrolled in an ag-related post-high school education.

The \$1,000 Gordon Berg Memorial Scholarship will be given to a student enrolled in a technical college, two-year, or short course agriculture program.

Other memorial scholarships include the Dorris Morris Memorial Scholarship and a \$1,000 Bradley Fust Memorial Scholarship.

Eligibility for all scholarships:

1. Applicant must be a member of the Wisconsin Holstein Association at the time of application.
2. Applicant must be presently enrolled in a four-year, one or two year tech school or a short course program in an ag-related field. There is no age limit.
3. Applicant must be available for an interview if selected as a finalist.
4. Scholarships administered by the WHA Scholarship Committee are capped at \$1,000 per scholarship recipient. Previous winners who were awarded less than \$1,000 can apply again. (This \$1,000 cap includes all scholarships administered by WHA, including 2-year, 4-year, and all memorial scholarships.)

5. Please include two letters, or have them sent to the WHA office, of recommendation, one of which must be from your academic advisor.
