



Application for 2025 Wisconsin Holstein Royalty

This is a position for female Wisconsin Junior Holstein members that are interested in becoming an ambassador for the Wisconsin Holstein Association (WHA). Two candidates will be selected to serve a one-year term as the Wisconsin Holstein Princess and Wisconsin Holstein Princess Attendant. In both of these roles, you will be asked to travel throughout the state to various events, make speaking and educational appearances, hand out awards at the appropriate events and be called upon to give brief speeches. You will act as a hostess of WHA-sponsored events.

Entrant must be between the ages of 16 to 20 as of January 1 of the year to become the Wisconsin Holstein Princess or Attendant.

Requirements/Expectations:

1. You will be required to interview at the Wisconsin Junior Holstein Convention. This interview takes precedence over other events at the Junior Holstein Convention.
2. You will be required to participate in the senior speaking contest at the Junior Holstein Convention.
3. You will be required to sign an extended youth policy regarding WHA rules and expectations.
4. Expectations are for the WHA Princess and Attendant to be available throughout the summer to represent WHA at various events when requested. This includes WHA-hosted events, as well as any outside dairy interests and dairy educational opportunities such as community events, county fair futurities, Cows on the Concourse, World Dairy Expo, etc.

 - a. Resume - including your name, complete address, primary phone number, email, age as of January 1, 2025, parents' or guardians' name and address.
 - b. Holstein Activities - list your Holstein activities
 - i. Year Event Achievement/Award or Leadership Position
 - c. School and/or Community Activities: list your activities
 - i. Year Event Achievement/Award or Leadership Position
 - d. Please include one headshot photo and a 100-word biography to be used for media releases (original photo or electronic copy, please no scans or printed photos).
2. Questions – Answer the following 3 questions on one 8.5" x 11" size paper in 12-point, single-spaced type to accompany your resume:
 - a. If you are chosen to be one of the two WHA Princesses, how and where would you like to help promote the WHA to non-members, youth and/or adults?
 - b. What is the best asset you will bring to this position and how would you use this asset to promote the association?
 - c. What are your future goals?

Please include two letters of recommendation from an employer, teacher, county leader or guidance counselor. Letters should address qualities that individuals excel in to make a great ambassador for the WI Holstein Association.
